Make a Plan to Vote Early by Mail or In-Person Ahead of Election Day

The League of Women Voters of the Morris Area encourages everyone to vote early ahead of the November 5th General Election. New Jersey voters can cast their ballots early in-person or by mail. There is no reason to wait until the last minute to vote!

In New Jersey, any eligible registered voter can Vote-by-Mail, but they need to apply. To receive a Vote-by-Mail Ballot by mail, the mailed application must be received by the County Clerk by October 29, 2024. Voters can also apply in-person to the County Clerk up until 3 pm on November 4, 2024. Visit nj.gov/state/elections/vote-by-mail to download a Vote-by-Mail application.

Vote-by-Mail ballots can be returned in one of three ways: using a secure ballot drop box in your county, by mail, or in-person to your County Board of Elections. All ballots must be returned or postmarked by Election Day, November 5.

You can vote early in-person at designated early voting locations in your county, using a voting machine, October 26, 2024, to November 3, 2024, from 10 am - 8 pm on weekdays and Saturdays, and from 10 am - 6 pm on Sundays.

At VOTE411.org, you can register to vote, verify your voter registration status, look up your ballot, and find out how candidates stand on critical policy issues.
